**SHARE LENT**: This Sunday is Share Lent Solidarity Sunday. We are asked to show forth the justice and compassion of Christ through our acts of generosity and solidarity with our sisters and brothers in the Global South. As Pope Francis reminds us, "If we really wish to prepare a path to peace in our world, let us commit ourselves to remedying the remote causes of injustice, settling unjust and unpayable debts and feeding the hungry.

SHARE LENT CAMPAIGN: Turn Debt to Hope. Today, in the Global South, more than 100 countries are facing a debt crisis. 3.3 billion people live in countries that spend more on debt servicing than on health or education. The countries that spend more on debt servicing than on health and education. The countries face crushing debt payments that keep them from investing in their people. At the same time, countries in the Global North owe them for exploiting their resources and destroying their environment. This destruction drives climate change which most adversely affects societies in the South that are least responsible for it.
