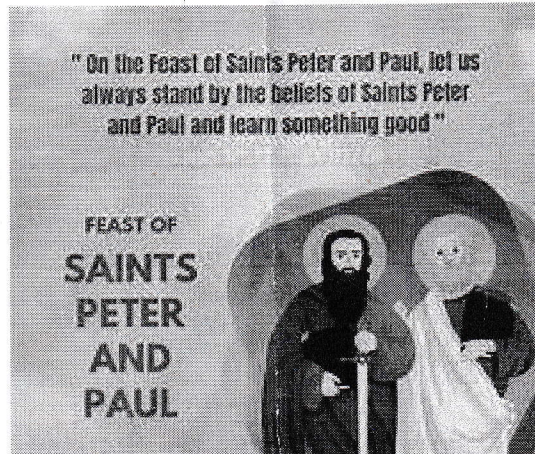


HOLY ROSARY PARISH BULLETIN
